

# SIZING GUIDE

This guide will allow you to choose your ring or bracelet size correctly.

If you are printing this document to choose your ring or bracelet size, make sure that no scaling is done when printing.

You can check that the tools have been printed correctly by making sure that the sample is precisely 2 centimeters.



## RINGS

It is best to measure your finger circumference at the end of the day. Avoid taking your measurements when your finger is hot or cold.

Also, please note that the measurements of your fingers change slightly from one hand to the other.

To find your ring size there are two methods:

1. Measuring your finger size
2. Use one of your rings that fits your finger size perfectly.

### Measuring your finger circumference to choose your ring size

- If you have a tape measure available, measure your finger circumference with it. Then match your measurement in millimetres to the nearest one in the table below. You will then find the right size for your ring.
- If you don't have a tape measure, take a thread or piece of paper and wrap it around the base of your finger. Mark the point where the wire/paper closes the circle. On a flat surface, measure the length in millimetres from the beginning of the thread/paper to your mark with a ruler.

Using the ring size chart, match your measurement in millimeters to the closest one in the table below. You will then find the right size for your ring.

Choosing the size of your ring from an existing ring

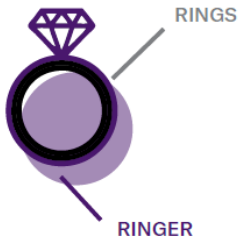
If you have a ring that fits perfectly the finger on which you will wear your Bäumer creation, you can use the ringer below.

Print out the size table. Before printing it, please make sure that no scaling is done when printing. Check that size 44 measures 14.01mm with a ruler.

Position your ring over the drawn circles, make sure that the inside of the ring is aligned with the circle that best fits. You will then find the right size for your ring.

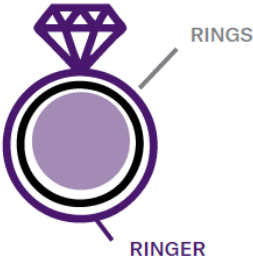
If your ring fits between two sizes, it is best to choose the larger one. It is always possible to make a size adjustment after purchase if necessary.

The inner circumference of the ring is NOT aligned with the outer contour of the circle.



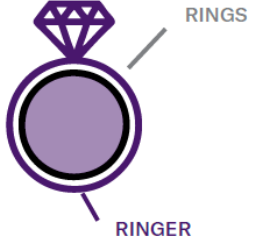
YOU MUST CHOOSE THE SMALLEST RING.

IT'S THE RIGHT SIZE.

Bäumer uses European sizes as a reference. Please refer to the size table above to find the equivalent in your country.



## BRACELET

To find your bracelet size there are two methods:

1. Measure your wrist size.
2. Use one of your bracelets that fits you well.

When choosing your bracelet size take into account your preference to wear your bracelets: adjusted or comfortably. Depending on, add or remove centimetres.

### Measure your wrist circumference to choose your bracelet size

- If you have a tape measure available, wrap it around your wrist to measure your bracelet size. Assimilate your measurement in centimetres to the nearest available in the size selection. You will then find the right size for your bracelet.
- If you don't have a tape measure, take a thread or piece of paper and wrap it around your wrist.  
Mark the point where the thread/paper closes the circle.  
On a flat surface, measure the length in centimetres from the beginning of the thread/paper to your mark with a ruler.  
Match your centimetre measurement to the closest available in the size chart. You will then find the right size for your bracelet.
- If you would like to measure your wristband size with the "Bäumer Wrist Ruler", please print out the next page.  
Before printing, please make sure that no scaling is done when printing.  
Cut out the ruler and adjust it to your wrist to measure your wristband size.  
Match your measurement in centimetres to the nearest available measurement in the size selection. This will help you find the right size for your bracelet.

### Use one of your bracelets that fits you well

If you have a bracelet that fits you perfectly you can use it to find the size of the bracelet on which you will wear your Bäumer creation.

- Place the bracelet on a flat surface.
- Measure the length of the bracelet between the end of the bracelet and the clasp.
- Based on the measurement, choose your Bäumer bracelet size.
